**BY SIGNING THE AGREEMENT FOR GROUP USE OF THE
ALLENDALE COMMUNITY PARK,
the applicant agrees to the following terms and agrees to share this
information with those attending the group event**

Bringing structures into the park

- No person may bring recreational structures (such as large blow up games, tents, etc.) into the park for use at their event unless specifically approved in writing in advance by a Township official. Dunk tanks are not allowed for insurance reasons. The grassy area just north of the restrooms is the area used to set up structures. Structures may not be set up in other areas without permission.

Hours of operation

- No person may be in the park between the hours of 11:00 pm and 8:00 am, or at such time as the park may be designated as closed to the public.

Preservation of natural features

- No person may deface or disturb any tree, sapling, seedling, bush, flower or the sod.
- No person may deface or destroy any monument, marker, building, sign, equipment, or other structure.

Fires

- No person may set a fire, except within receptacles designed for such purposes. Open fires are prohibited.
- No person may leave any approved fire unattended. All permitted fires must be completely extinguished before leaving the vicinity of the fire.

Hunting

- No person may hunt, trap, catch, wound, kill, or treat cruelly any bird or animal.

Firearms

- No person may bring into the park, or have in his/her possession, any type of firearm.

Fireworks

- No person may bring into the park, or have in his/her possession, any type of firecracker device.

Littering

- No person may deposit waste except by placing waste in refuse containers.
- Groups are responsible for cleaning up their own waste. Bring garbage bags and dispose of them afterward in the dumpster area behind the wood fence just north of the maintenance building.

Personal Conduct

- No person may engage in indecent or obscene conduct.
- No person may sunbathe or swim in the nude.
- No person may make unreasonable or excessive noise or create a disturbance.
- No person may play any kind of sound producing device in a manner which is unreasonable loud, raucous or a nuisance to others within the area of audibility.
If a speaker system is used, direct the speakers to your own group only, and keep the volume down.
- No person may urinate or defecate except in a restroom facility provided for that purpose.
- No person may enter a restroom facility designated for the opposite gender.
- No person may be intoxicated or under the influence of a controlled substance.
- No person may consume alcoholic beverages.
- No person may commit an assault upon another.
- No person may disobey any authorized sign.
- No person may conduct gambling, except as permitted by State law.
- No person may distribute or place upon Township property any sign, banner, advertisement, circular, etc., unless specifically approved in writing in advance by a Township official.

Animals and pets

- Animals are prohibited in the park, except areas which are posted to permit animals. Working leader and service dogs are permitted in all areas.
- In areas where animals are permitted, animals must be kept on a leash no greater than six feet in length.
- Animals found not in the possession of or under the control of the owner may be removed.

Camping

- No person may establish any camp or other temporary lodging place.

Traffic

- All vehicles must operate on roadways or parking lots.
- Motorized bikes, snowmobiles, ATVs and similar vehicles are prohibited.
- The speed limit is 10 mph through the park.

Commercial activities, peddling and soliciting

- No person may operate a business whatsoever without authorization in writing from a Township official.

Picnic shelter

- Only one picnic shelter may be reserved. If a group has reserved the one shelter, they may not also occupy the remaining picnic shelter...the remaining shelter must be left open for public use! Rent for the shelter is \$25.00.
