

OUTDOOR VENDORS LICENSE ORDINANCE AMENDMENT

Ordinance No. 2013-13

AN ORDINANCE to amend the outdoor vendors license adopted by Allendale Charter Township to specify the permitted areas of operation and to provide for the effective date of this Ordinance.

THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF ALLENDALE, COUNTY OF OTTAWA, STATE OF MICHIGAN ORDAINS:

Section 1. Amendment of Section 3 of the Outdoor Vendors License Ordinance: Section 3 of the Outdoor Vendors License Ordinance adopted by Allendale Charter Township shall be amended to state in its entirety as follows:

Section 3. Permitted Areas Of Operation.

A. An Outdoor Vendors operation within Allendale Charter Township shall be permitted in the following districts:

1. C-1 Limited Business District;
2. C-2 General Business District;
3. GC General Commercial
4. C-3 Service Commercial District;
5. I-1 Light Industrial District;
6. PID Planned Industrial District.

B. An Outdoor Vendors operation within Allendale Charter Township shall also be permitted in approved Planned Unit Developments which are commercial/industrial in nature.

C. An Outdoor Vendor shall not operate within any public right-of-way.

Section 11. Validity.

Should any section, clause, or provision of this Ordinance be declared by the Courts to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than that part declared to be invalid.

Section 12. Severability And Captions.

This Ordinance and the various parts, sections, subsections, sentences, phrases and clauses thereof are hereby declared to be severable. If any part, section, subsection, sentence, phrase or clause is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid, it is hereby declared that the remainder

of this Ordinance shall not be affected thereby. The captions included at the beginning of each section are for convenience only and shall not be considered as a part of this Ordinance.

Section 13. Administrative Liability.

No officer, agent, or employee of the Township shall render himself or herself personally liable for any damage, consequence, or occurrence that may occur to any person as a result of any act performed in the discharge of his or her duties pursuant to this Ordinance.

Section 14. Repeal.

This Ordinance shall be deemed to repeal all other Ordinances or parts thereof which are in conflict in whole or in part with any of the provisions of this Ordinance as of the effective date of this Ordinance.

Section 15. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall become effective seven days after publication thereof and shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the Township of Allendale. The forgoing Ordinance was adopted at a regular meeting of the Allendale Charter Township Board held on _____ 2015
